Dr Loren Mosher is famous for his work in setting up Soteria in the USA in the late 1960's and 1970's. Previously he had worked with R.D Laing and developed Soteria as a means of helping support people with acute psychosis with a minimal use of drugs, and in a way that help people to try to make sense out of their experiences. It has been thoroughly evaluated. Soteria is now well established in the USA, and also in Switzerland and Germany in Europe. There is much interest in this country, and we are excited to be able to invite Loren to Bradford to talk about his work in the Centre for Citizenship and Community Mental Health.
